2:2-4 – How does James illustrate favoritism being shown by Christians? What does he conclude?

2:5-7 – How will keeping the right perspective keep you from showing favoritism? How is this illustrated?

2:8-11 – How is love a "royal" law? How will love impact whether or not you show favoritism? What happens whenever someone breaks any one of God's laws?

2:12-13 – What should dictate how you speak and act? Why is it so important to show mercy? How does showing mercy in judgment impact favoritism?
